The town public budget hearing was called to order by Chairman Henke at 7:00 p.m. Roll call taken and all board members present. (Larry Henke, Steve Sheldon, Mark Milbrandt, Jessica Jaeger, Cheryl Milbrandt)

Citizen inquiries and concerns: John Carberry questioned proposed road work and culvert replacement. Chairman Henke stated the board has allocated \$5000.00 in the road budget for culverts. Discussion on the cost of road repair and blacktopping and yearly maintenance of roads. Roy Yasick questioned whether the board needs to look at whether the local levy with DOT aids pay for needed roadwork. Request from the electors present to increase the town local levy to allow the town to maintain the town roads.

Motion by Mark Milbrandt and seconded by Steve Sheldon to hold a special town meeting on December 6, 2017, the electors of the Town of Neshkoro, Marquette County, Wisconsin, with proper notice, authorize the Town of Neshkoro to exceed the allowable state levy limit. All in favor, Motion carried.

The proposed Town of Neshkoro Budget was presented and discussed. Decision by board to not adopt the budget until after the special electors tax levy meeting on December 6, 2018.
